1. C.T.U. 78.1.16 released this vessel in vicinity of Point "Whirlaway" at #125 Item, 1 May 1945, after F-1 Day Operation of Commander Amphibious Group SIX Attack Order No. A 604-45 had been successfully completed. This vessel took station with the Attack Force (SCHELON O-1-F) at #2#4, and proceeded to objective area. C.T.U. 78.1.4 transferred to this vessel from U.S.S. ROCKY MOUNT (AGC 3) at #7#7, and at #7#8 this command reported on station as Landing Craft Control vessel off Red Beach (LINKAS).

2. C.T.U. 78.1.4 directed beaching operations from this vessel until 1200, 3 May 1945. After being released by C.T.U. 78.1.4 at this time, this command reported to C.T.U. 78.1.2 for screening assignment.

3. No enemy contact was made during this operation, and no rounds of ammunition were expended. All elements of this command performed capably, and satisfactorily.
