8. GSO III (Int)

- Latest infm on present air ph coverage further requests by (a) 1 Aust Corps incl:-
 - Low obliques of coast of southern TARAKAN, low tide. (i)
 - Low obliques of coast of southern TARAKAN, high tide. (ii)
 - Verticels of area surrounding TARAKAN town and SOUTH (111)corner of TARAKAH ISLAND.
- Chliques of beaches taken 31 Mar NOT yet to hand. (i)
- A diagram of tide, sunlight, moonlight and TARAKAN has been issued to 26 Aust Inf Ede. moonlight and twilight data for
- 2000 captured documents and eapt tags have been requisitioned. (d)
- GOC requested daily sitreps giving shipping sightings, enemy movs, air activity, etc in area OBOE ONE and OBOE TWO.

4. GSO III (Air)

- Following pts were discussed at Bomber Cond conference:-
 - A landing has been made in the OKTHAWA gp (approx (1)half way between FORMOSA and JAPAM). Progress has been satisfactory.
 - CHAIR mirfd in SOUTH BOWER hit by Liberators on $(\pm i)$ three successive days. Runways word heavily cratered.

4. DAGMG

- 9 Aust Div have requested 1000 extra med stretchers for (E) OBCE CME.

 - 2
 - 13 jeeps
 - trailers

(c) At a conference on lighterage for OBOE ONE attended by:-

CO 593 EB and S Regt Cond 2 Aust Beach Cp SC 26 Aust Inf Ede DATIG PLO

it was decided that unless lighterage more suitable for the nature of the beach could be provided, present allotment of LCMs is sufficient.

- 5. GOC gave outline of ourrent situation on AA Arty -
 - (a) Four regts only are available to 1 Aust Corps.
 - (b) 9 Aust Div has been allotted two for OBOE CHE and OBOE TWO unlikely that any more would be available.
 - (c) The main tasks in both operations are airfields and military areas. Tours and oil fields and will take secondary priority.
 - (d) The extent to which AA arty can be moved from GBOE ONE to OBOE TWO depends on enemy interference at OBOE ONE and on availability of shipping.
 - (e) To decide best employment of AA arty, it will be necessary to study air intelligence more electly to determine how much enony air activity is likely to be encountered and how much damage is likely to be encountered from the various types of aircraft known to be in the area.
 - (f) CRA and RAAF should study sir intelligence electly and make appreciation.

6. RAAF representative

- (a) Advised that RAAF Come have received an Allied Air Operation Instruction which includes following instructions of general interest:-
 - (1) Changes RAAT area of responsibility to include HALMAHERAS and BORTEC.
 - (ii) A courier service MOROTAL TARAKAM, TARAKAM MANTLA is to be established. As the aircraft will be operational CATALINAS initially load carrying capacity will be limited.
- (b) Auster directed will arrive LOROTAL 6 Apr.
