0800 - Anchored as before. 0803 Started main engines and prepared to get underway for beaching. 0824 Anchor aweigh and underway to Brown Beach, LABUAN Island, BORNEO. 0835 Let go stern anchor. 0836 Beached at Brown beach on course 008 T, with 350 feet stern anchor cable at the waters edge. 0837 Secured special sea detail. 1030 Started loading LVT's on tank deck. 1045 Completed loading LVT's. Watch reported all secure.
