Subject: Action Report on Brunei Bay, Borneo, Operation.

1. In this operation of Brunei Bay, Borneo, (3 Day), this ship served as a combat loaded and surgically staffed ship. Rehearsals for this operation were held at Morotai on 31 May 1945. LVT's were launched according to plan and escorted to line of advance by two (2) of this ship's LCV's acting as wave guides. All features of landing operation carried out on schedule.

2. This ship departed from Morotai 4 June 1945, in convoy and arrived in Brunei Bay attack area prepared for assault on White Beach, Maura Island, 10 June 1945. LVT's were launched on schedule with two (2) of this ship's LCV's acting as number one wave guide boats. Landings were made on schedule and unopposed. No casualties were suffered. Three additional small boats from this ship were used throughout the operation in accordance with the Commander, LST Flotilla FIFTEEN (15) Landing Attack Order 1-45. At 1130, 10 June 1945, this ship beached on Red Beach, Maura Island and unloaded mechanized equipment. Retracted at 1342 and proceeded to anchorage area. Commenced unloading bulk cargo on pontoon barges at 1535, 10 June 1945. Completed unloading bulk cargo at 2015, 11 June 1945. Remained in Brunei Bay area operating as a casualty evacuation ship.

3. No contact was made with enemy surface units or enemy aircraft. No ammunition expended. Ship's personnel and equipment satisfactory.
